## **Criteria for Eligibility**

- -Applicants must be practicing Catholics.
- -Must be graduating from 12th Grade.
- -Must be attending an accredited school or institution of higher education i.e.: 2 or 4-year college or trade school this fall.
- -Belong to one of the following Parishes: St. Patrick, Yorkville, IL. / St. Mary's Plano IL.
- -Must complete all applications, prepare essays on the assigned topics and should receive a letter of recommendation.
- -The children of members Council #14463 are eligible to participate even if they do not belong to one of the local Parish's listed above provided they fulfill the list of criteria on this application.

## **Scholarship Selection Process**

- A committee chosen by the scholarship chairman shall review the applications, essays, and letters of recommendation.
- The members of the committee will rank (score) the candidates according to the application, essays, and letters of recommendation.
- The scholarship chairman shall calculate the scores submitted by the judges.
- Scholarship shall be awarded using this scoring method.
- All names are removed from the application for review by the committee.

#### **Instructions:**

- 1. Choose **any 2 topics** (listed on the next page) and write a separate essay on each.
- 2. Type your essays on separate pages.
- 3. Clearly identify the topic of your essay, on the essay page.
- 4. Include these pages in your application, and page numbers on all essay pages.
- 5. Each essay should be approximately 500 words. Please submit your essay in double space format, 12 pt. Times New Roman or Arial typeface.

- The Knights of Columbus Council # 14463 is awarding a scholarship of \$2,000 as the Billy Mahaney Memorial Scholarship.
- Applicants are to be graduating 12thgraders, generally from the parishes of St. Patrick's of Yorkville, IL and St. Mary's of Plano, IL. Children of Council #14463 members are also eligible, regardless of their parish.
- Applicants are to be practicing Catholics.

- UNACCEPTED FILE TYPES images, GIF, JPG, PNG
